

TSDEECET-2017 WEB BASED COUNSELLING FOR LEFTOVER AND NON-REPORTING VACANCIES.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES FOR SUBMISSION OF PREFERENCES FOR SELECTION OF COLLEGES THROUGH WEB BASED COUNSELING FOR “LEFT OVER AND NON-REPORTING VACANCIES”

1. Allotment of seats for admission into Two Year D.El.Ed Course in the State for 2017-19 batch for ‘Left over and Non Reporting vacancies’ will be made through Web Based Counseling as per merit & rank obtained in DEECET 2017.
2. The process of admission involves three stages:
 - (i) Verification of certificates of candidates qualified in DEECET-2017 for ‘Left over and Non-Reporting Vacancies’
 - (ii) Online submission of preferences of colleges through Web Based application.
 - (iii) Allotment of seats
 - (iv) Download of Allotment Letter.
3. The Web Based Counseling for the ‘Left over and Non-Reporting Vacancies’ will be from 13-09-2017 to 16-09-2017 as detailed below:
 - i. Submission of web based options from any of the DIETs through online service provided to the Principal of DIETs who have qualified in DEECET 2017 after due verification of certificates at DIETs from **13-09-2017 to 16-09-2017**.
 - ii. Candidates shall bring the following original certificates for verification of certificates.
 - a) SSC
 - b) Intermediate (Intermediate vocational courses are not eligible)
 - c) Transfer Certificate from the institution where last studied.
 - d) Integrated Community Certificate issued by MRO for candidates admitted under quota for reservation of BC/SC/ST categories or exemption of fee.

- e) Study Certificates from Class IV to X. In case of private study residence certificates issued by the MRO.
- f) PH certificate issued by the District Medical Board in case of candidates admitted under quota for PH category.
- g) Special Category Certificate issued by the Officials concerned for claiming admission under quota of reservation for Special categories (Defence personnel or their children and spouses, NCC, Rashtrapathi Awardee Scouts and Guides, Sports and Games).
- h) In case of candidates seeking exemption of fee candidates shall produce Income Certificate issued by Tahsildar after 01-01-2017 of parent.
- i) For differently abled the certificate submitted in proof should be issued by the Director, Medical and Health Services, Telangana State as per G.O.Ms.No.10/SE (Prog.II) Dept. dt. 12-04-2017.
- j) As per rules the candidate should have passed the Intermediate or its equivalent should have secured 50% of marks in aggregate and in case of SC/ST/PHC it is 45%) . In DEECET-2017 minimum qualifying marks for OC and BC is 35 and there is no minimum qualifying marks for SC and ST.
- k) Principal, DIETs may follow other rules if any as per G.O.Ms.No.10/SE (Prog.II) Dept. dt. 12-04-2017.

iii. Candidates who joined in 1st and 2nd phases are not eligible to exercise options in this web based counseling.

iv. Schedule of Allotment of seats for “Left over and Non-reporting vacancies”.

Allotment of seats to the candidates based on the merit order and rule of reservation	18-09-2017

Reporting of candidates to the college	18-09-2017 & 21-09-2017

4. Steps to be followed in Web Based Counselling by the Principals of DIETs and Candidate.

- i. To begin with, download the list of colleges granted permission by the affiliation committee for admissions for the 2017-19 batch hosted on TSDEECET website <http://tsdeecet.cgg.gov.in> and prepare the order of preferences of colleges.
- ii. The list of districts will be displayed on the screen. Select the districts in which you wish to seek admission. The list of colleges in those districts will be displayed.
- iii. Follow the 'On Screen' instructions and messages that are given during the course of selection of your preferences (Colleges). Try to select as many colleges as possible as that would increase the possibility of getting admission. There is no maximum number for selection of colleges. You can select all the colleges in the list.
- iv. After selection of colleges is over press the 'Submit' button but before pressing the 'Submit' button please check thoroughly the preferences submitted.
- v. On pressing the 'Submit' button the pdf of the list of colleges submitted will be displayed. Download the list PDF of submitted preferences list.
- vi. **Do not forget that the candidate is only responsible for submission of preferences.**
- vii. Submission of preferences through Web Based Counseling is not the end of admission procedure. It is only registration for admission. Allotment of seats will be made exclusively in the order of merit through a web based programme.

- viii. All the candidate who are allotted seats in any of the colleges as per merit and the order of preference of colleges will be sent through SMS on their registered mobile.
- ix. The college-wise selected list of candidates will be displayed on the screen and the candidate must take a printout of web options exercised by him/her. The Principal should keep the copies with the signature of the candidates of the same.
- x. Candidate shall visit the website <http://tsdeecet.cgg.gov.in> to know 'provisional allotment' and **make fee payment** as mentioned therein on **18-09-2017 & 19-09-2017**.
- xi. **Fee Structure:**
Govt. Colleges: Rs.2385/-
Private Colleges: Tuition fee - Rs.11,000/- per annum and Special Fee Rs.1500/- per annum.
- xii. Exemption from payment of fee:
a) The candidates belonging to the following categories are **exempted from payment of fee provided they have produced the income certificate of parents** issued by the Tahsildar after 01-01-2017 **for claiming exemption of fee at the time of verification of certificates.**
i. SC & ST candidates less than 2.00 lakh per annum
ii. BC candidates of Rural Area Rs.1.50 lakh
iii. BC candidates of Urban area Rs.2.00 lakh
iv. OC disabled candidates Rs.1.00 lakh
v. EBC candidates 1.00 lakh
b) However, all the candidates have to pay Rs.1500/- Special Fee using make payment link by providing required details in the website.
- xiii. The copy of acknowledgement of fee paid in gateway should be submitted in the allotted college on the day of reporting at the college.

- xiv. After successful payment of fees, the candidate shall download “Final Allotment Letter” from the web site in <http://tsdeecet.cgg.gov.in> from **18-09-2017 to 21-09-2017**.
- xv. The Principal / Correspondent of the college concerned shall submit the list of candidates reported in the college to Principal, Govt. DIET concerned on **22-09-2017** without fail failing which action will be initiated as per rules.
- xvi. On receipt of list of candidates from college in the respective Districts, the Principal, Govt. DIET shall report to the CGG, college wise through tracking service on **22-09-2017**.
